Laurel Street Arts artists explore many different art forms and media! Our artists are boys and girls going into grades 2 through 7 and work on several age-appropriate projects every day.



Registration and a non-refundable \$100 deposit per child, per week, are required for all sessions. Prices include cost of all project materials. Artists attending Session A (or A*) should bring their own lunch and drink. Laurel Street Arts reserves the right to change the curriculum.

Everyone knows that art is important, rewarding, and a lot of fun! Our knowledgeable and enthusiastic staff will lead your kids through an exploration of various artistic media. Whether your artist is new to the medium or experienced, our instructors offer tips, techniques, and inspiration to help them make the most of their talents.



We choose our multi-media crafts based on the kids participating, offering crafts for both girls and boys, and using all types of materials. Kids will work on two to four projects per day.

Our camp is for kids going into grades 2 through 7. We offer three different 5-day camp sessions, geared toward age, each either 3 or 3.5 hours per day. (The last 2 weeks of the summer are 4-day sessions.)

Register before May 1, 2012 and receive a \$5.00 discount per child per week.

Note: While the curriculum may be repeated from week to week, the individual projects may change somewhat so repeat artists can have a varied experience. Artists may not, however, attend more than 2 weeks per summer.

Special arrangements can be made to drop off artists as early as 9:00 am or pick them up as late as 2 hours after end of camp. Cost for extra time & project is \$10 per 30 minutes. One week notice is required.

We will begin accepting registrations on February 15, 2012. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. We will have a waiting list for full sessions and will fill the classes from the earliest name on the list. Sessions that do not meet minimum enrollment may be cancelled. A non-refundable \$100 per child, per week, deposit is required to hold a space. The balance is due prior to the first class. No refund of tuition (or portion thereof) will be granted for absences.
