



BIRTHDAY PARTY FAQ's AT LAUREL STREET ARTS

What is the maximum amount of painters you can accommodate?

- 40 for a children's birthday party
- 50 for an adult event (birthdays/team buildings/group events)
- We have a 12 artist minimum for private events (after or before hours)
- We have a 12 person maximum for in-studio parties (during studio hours)

How do I make a reservation?

- Email the studio studio@laurelstreetarts.com
- We do not take reservations over the phone
- We do not take reservations in person
- Please expect to wait 48 hours for a response

When will our pieces be ready?

- Pottery = 7 - 10 days
- Glass Fusing = 2 weeks
- Mosaics = Take home that day and complete grouting at home
- We will let the party host know when pieces are ready to be picked up and you have two options:
 1. Pick up the whole bag of individually labeled pieces to distribute
 2. Let your guests know that their pieces are ready and can be picked up under the last name of the person who paid for the party

What do we need to bring?

- We will provide everything needed for the project and it is covered in the cost

- If you are having food/cupcakes, you will need to bring everything for that including plates, cups, napkins and candles

Do I need to put down a deposit?

- We do not require a deposit, we will collect payment in full on the day of the event according to final numbers and pieces picked to paint
- Your party is confirmed by email

Are decorations ok?

- You can bring decorations if you are hosting a PRIVATE event
- If you have an event during studio hours, you can bring decorations for outside, after the painting/project portion
- We have 3 tables outside, if you wanted to put table cloths on them, they are 5.5ft long

Can we eat inside?

- No, all food should be outside unless it is raining
- Drinks are allowed inside
- We do not encourage drinks at the table when working on projects for a children's birthday party

Is 1.5 hours enough time?

- Yes! Especially for younger children
- We do not rush you away, but the invite should say 1.5 hours for a PRIVATE party
- The 1.5 hours includes the project and time for food
- There is an option to add .5 hours for \$75

When do you need a headcount?

- We will reach out a few days before your event

How do you make sure we stay within our budget?

- If you are coming in for a children's birthday, we have shelves that keep the pieces at \$25 or under
- If you are coming in for a 10yr old or up birthday, we can set a budget that one of our team members will relay to your group — guests will find a lot of great pieces for \$25

What is the average cost of a birthday party?

- \$135 Private Party Fee
- \$10/artist studio fee + ~\$25/person for a pottery painting party
- \$10/artist studio fee + \$36/person for a glass fusing party
- \$10/artist studio fee + \$25/person for a mosaic frame

What if I planned a private party and don't end up meeting the minimum?

- If you do not have 12, you can pay for pieces, take them home and return to paint them for just the studio fee of \$10
- You can have your guests paint more pieces
